Saugerties – Andrew Remsen died Saturday, July 23, 2016 at HealthAlliance of the Hudson Valley Broadway Campus after a long illness. He was 41 years old.

Born July 19, 1975 in Oneida, NY, he was the son of Sherwood “Butch” and Susan Willig Remsen. He was employed as an arborist by various local tree services and owned Andy’s Tree Service.

Andy was active in the 4H program and regularly competed in the Dog Obedience Classes. He also enjoyed raising Chickens and Ducks.
