Saugerties – Anthony “Tony” Fabiano, a devoted husband and loving father and grandfather, entered into eternal life Saturday April 30, 2016 at HealthAlliance of Hudson Valley Broadway Campus. He was 88 years old.

Born December 24, 1927 in Glasco, NY, he was the son of Michael and Marietta Garitono Fabiano. On October 26, 1957 he married the former Amelia G. Mauro.

Tony retired after 30 years from Rotron in 1989. He spent his early years working on the family farm. He was a life member of the Glasco Fire Company. A US Army veteran of the Korean War, he was also a member of Lamouree-Hackett Post #72 American Legion.
