Glasco – Arthur Ferraro died Thursday, May 7, 2009 at Tenbroeck Commons Nursing Home in Lake Katrine. He was 83 years old. Arthur was born July 22, 1925 in Glasco, the son of Joseph and Mary Martini Ferraro. He married the former Mary T. Rinaldi, who died August 30, 1993. He retired from the Town of Saugerties Highway Department. He was also a parishioner of St. Joseph's Church in Glasco. Survivors include his brother, Joseph Ferraro, Jr. of Glasco; three sisters-in-law, Fiorina Ferraro and Caroline Ferraro; Rose Rinaldi and several nieces and nephews.
