



Benjamin Barry Hill

February 6, 1942 - February 19, 2025

Palenville – Benjamin Barry Hill died Wednesday February 19, 2025 at the Albany VA Medical Center. He was 83 years old.

Born February 6, 1942 in Woodstock, NY he was the son of the late Ben F. Hill and the late Shirley Bonesteel Hill. He served in the US Army during the 1960's and was the proprietor of Ben Hill Well Drilling in Palenville. An avid hunter and fisherman, Barry was also a member of the Saugerties Elks.

Survivors include his longtime partner Louann Janz: his children Barry Hill and his wife Rachel of Palenville and his daughter Erika Hill and her partner James Felter of Earlton, NY; his grandchildren Marissa, Jessica, Emily and Barry Jr.: his great-grandson Reed; and his siblings Bonnie Ziliani, Bart Hill and Brenda Hill. He is also survived by many nieces and nephews.
