OBITUARY Saugerties – Brian “Sunshine” Rine died Friday November 29, 2013 at Kingston Hospital after a long illness. He was 44 years old. Born July 9, 1969 in Ellenville, NY, he was the son of William Jr. and Joan Grunski Rine. He was a Truck Driver most recently employed by County Waste in Cairo. A Volunteer Fireman for many years, he was a member of the Malden West Camp Fire Co. for more than 10 years and the Napanoch Fire Department prior to that. He was an avid fan of the Dallas Cowboys, NY Yankees, and Dale Earnhardt.
