Saugerties – Dori J. O'Connell, 63, died Wednesday, June 4, 2008 at her home, after a long battle with cancer. A 1962 graduate of Saugerties High School, Dori attended Hartford Aviation School and worked for Eastern Airlines until starting her family. Born October 28, 1944, she was the daughter of Claude and Marie Post of Saugerties. In addition to her parents, survivors include two daughters, Kristen O'Connell of Buffalo, Shannon O'Connell of Shady, three sons, Daniel, Owen and Joseph O'Connell of Saugerties, two sisters - Jean Fellows of Saugerties, Adele Zinderman of Kingston, two brothers – C. Howard Post of Saugerties and Kenneth Post of Pleasant Valley. A brother, David, died in infancy. Also surviving are her former husband and good friend, father of her children, Jeremiah O'Connell, and her companion of several years, Peter Kick, both of Saugerties. Dori was an avid nature lover who enjoyed hiking, canoeing, sailing and biking . She was a poet and co-authored a New York hiking guide book.
