OBITUARY Saugerties – Eileen Gaebel passed away suddenly Sunday October 27, 2013 at St. Peter’s Hospital in Albany, NY. She was 56 years old. At her bedside during the week was her devoted husband, Klaus, her loving daughter, Karisa, and her very close friends Liz and Pat Flannery. Born April 22, 1957 in Kingston, NY, she was the daughter of Harry and Delta Williams Zehnick. She was raised from childhood by her God Parents, Walt and Mary Wilson. On March 28, 1981 she married the love of her life, Klaus Gaebel, at St. Joseph’s Church in Glasco, NY. She was employed by Benedictine Hospital in various clerical duties for more than 35 years and most recently was in Outpatient Scheduling for HealthAlliance, the successor of Benedictine Hospital. She enjoyed getting together with family and hosting friends, entertaining, and loved both cooking and baking and taking care of the cats she had in her life. She loved to travel, having been to Europe over six times, and enjoyed bringing back gifts for the children of friends. Eileen was very active in her daughter’s life, from school activities to her daughter’s equestrian events and taking care of Texas Star – the horse owned by the daughter. Both a loving and devoted mother and wife, she leaves loving memories to be cherished by her surviving husband of 32 years, Klaus Gaebel and their daughter, Karisa Gaebel, who is an extremely successful student at Western New England University in Massachusetts, and will begin her accounting career with a top-four accounting firm after graduation.
