Saugerties – Frank J. Spada, died Saturday, June 30, 2007 at home. He was 84 years old. He was born April 1, 1923 in Glasco, NY the son of Anthony and Maria Grano Spada. On October 23, 1949 he married the former Geraldine Mauro with whom he recently celebrated his 57th wedding anniversary. He retired from John A. Coleman High School in 1986 as Maintenance Supervisor. He was also a retiree of the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America. A member of St. Joseph's Church in Glasco and a former member of St. Mary of the Snow Parish he was a long serving Usher. He is also a life member of the Glasco Fire Company with over fifty years of service, a former Fire Commissioner and former Captain of Fire Police. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus third and fourth degrees in Saugerties, and a former member of both the Highwoods Sportsman Club and the Glasco Gun Club. In addition to his wife he is survived by two sisters, Antoniette Spada and Mary Spada; and a brother Michael Spada all of Saugerties. He was pre-deceased by his brother John Spada of Kingston and his sister; Rose Gallo of Saugerties. He is also survived by several nieces and nephews. A Funeral procession will form 9:30 AM, Tuesday July 3, 2007 at Buono Funeral Service, Inc., Main Street Chapel, Saugerties, NY and then proceed to St. Joseph's RC Church in Glasco where at 11:00 AM a Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated.
