Frederick John Lahl, age 80, of Saugerties, NY, died on Friday, August 18, 2017 at Kingston Hospital. He was born in Kingston, NY, to Loretta Thomas Lahl and Albert Charles Lahl. He was the youngest of three children and was predeceased by his brother Albert Lahl and sister Verna Longendyke.
