A graduate of George Washington High School in Manhattan and member of the swim team, he held the borough record for the backstroke for a time. In 1992 he retired as a Machinist from IBM in Kingston where he was a member of the Quarter Century Club. He was a life member and former commissioner of the Saxton Fire Co., member of the Blue Kats Men's Club and the Saugerties Fish and Game Club. Along with his late wife he was a member of the Kiskatom Reformed Church. Gunsmithing and bee keeping were among his interests and he was a member of the Catskill Mt. Bee Keepers Association. His wife Helena died April 19, 1995.
