Saugerties – George E. Nau died Thursday, January 19, 2017 after a long illness at HealthAlliance of the Hudson Valley Broadway Campus in Kingston. He was 66 years old.

I got to talking with him. He and I were of the same generation. It turned out he had a Novice License, WN2LFS, back in 1971. Unfortunately he did not advance past the Novice level and it expired 2 years later. He said he always wanted to get back into Ham Radio but he never did. That is until his nephew went and got a General License in June of 2014. This spurred George into studying for and passing the exams in December 2014. I started helping George as I've been a Ham since 1973. I got him into the Ulster County Weather Net and reporting the weather for Saugerties.
