Saugerties ? Inge W. Coomes died Friday, March 24, 2008 at Kingston Hospital. She was 85 years old. She had lived in the greater Hudson Valley area for over 40 years, moving to Poughkeepsie in 1966 and Shokan in 1969. In 1990 she and her husband, Claude, of 60 years, who survives, retired to Saugerties. Previously, she had resided in North Babylon, New York.
