



John F. "Fred" Hull

July 19, 1924 - February 22, 2008

Saugerties – John F. Hull, known as “Fred” to his family and friends, passed away Sunday evening, February 17, 2008 at Bassett Hospital in Cooperstown, New York. He was 83 years old. Born on July 19, 1924 in Malden-on-Hudson, NY, he was the fourth son of five boys born to Frances and William Hull. John married Anna Mazzaccone in 1948 and they lived in Saugerties all of their lives. Anna M. Hull passed away on February 7, 2000. He was a graduate of Saugerties High School and in 1943 enlisted into the United States Army. In WWII he served his country during the invasion of Normandy and the Rhineland and was awarded the European Africa Middle Eastern Service Medal, the Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. He worked for Blue Ribbon Cleaners and Flannigan Cleaners for many years. Most recently he had been employed by Rite Aid Pharmacy and Smith Hardware. As a member of St. Mary of the Snow Catholic Church he served as an usher and for many years was a Boy Scout Leader. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and was also a member of the American Legion. John was a devoted father and had a unique sense of humor. He is survived by his son, Joseph C. Hull and wife Linda Simmons Hull and his three granddaughters Katherine, Emily and Abigail of Cooperstown, New York. In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by his four brothers William, Martin, Robert and Joseph. A Funeral procession will form 9:15 AM Friday, February 22, 2008 at Buono Funeral Service, Inc., Main Street Chapel, Saugerties, NY and then proceed to St. Mary of the Snow where a 10:00 AM Mass of

Christian Burial will be celebrated. Rev. Christopher Berean, Pastor of St. Mary of the Snow will officiate. Interment will follow immediately in St. Mary of the Snow Cemetery, Barclay Heights.
