OBITUARY Glasco – John Sasso died peacefully Saturday, December 20, 2014, at Ten Broeck Commons Nursing Home in Lake Katrine. He was 98 years old. Born November 6, 1916, in Glasco, he was the son of Angelo and Teresa Yannone Sasso. He married Rose M. Mayone on September 7, 1941. John served as a US Army medic during WWII.
