OBITUARY INFORMATION Saugerties – Joseph A. Doyle died Sunday, September 26, 2010 at Benedictine Hospital. He was 54 years old. He was born August 30, 1956 in Kingston, the son of John “Joe” Doyle and Eileen Wynne Doyle. On June 3, 1979 he married the former Brenda Valk. He was employed for more than 25 years as an Emergency Services Dispatcher at Ulster County Fire Control and then Ulster County Communications 911 Center. For 31 years he was a football official for CHVFOA section 9; and in 2009 he refereed the Class AA New York State Championships in Syracuse, NY. A member of the Board of Directors of Saugerties Little League, he also served as coach for both Little League and Babe Ruth. He was a coach for the original Saugerties AYSO Soccer and served as a member of the Saugerties American Legion Sports Committee. A member of R. A. Snyder Hose and Past Chief of the Saugerties Fire Department, he also served as Fire Commissioner while a member of the Village of Saugerties Board. Active as an educator for the American Cancer Society he was the grand marshal of the 2009 Relay for Life in Saugerties. In addition to his wife, he is survived by his two children, Sarah Kathryn Doyle and Brenden Joseph “BJ” Doyle; his brother, Kevin Doyle; his adopted brothers, Johnno, Chris, and Richie Boryk; his niece, Lara Doyle, and several other nieces and nephews; also by two very special friends, Anthony Bell and Brian Martin. Survivors also include his father-in-law, Chief Dick Valk and the rest of the Valk Family. Funeral services will be held 10:00 am Thursday, September 30, 2010 at Buono Funeral

Service, Inc., Main Street Chapel, Saugerties, NY. Rev. James Alley, Pastor of the Blue Mt. Reformed Church, and Rev. Steven Valk will officiate. Interment will follow immediately in Blue Mt.
