OBITUARY Saugerties – Joseph A. Mazzola died Saturday, June 19, 2010 at Ferncliff Nursing Home in Rhinebeck, NY. He was 73 years old. Joe was born April 20, 1937 in Brooklyn, NY the son of Frank and Carmela Filosa Mazzola. His wife Dolores passed away on February 2, 2008. He retired from the New York Daily News in 1990. Prior to his employment he served in the US Navy for 10 years from 1954 until 1964; during which time he was inducted into the Sons of Neptune when he “crossed the line”, the initiation rite for crossing the equator.
