Saugerties, NY – Joseph D. Traver, died Saturday, September 16, 2023 at Northern Dutchess Hospital in Rhinebeck with his family at his side. He was 90 years old.

Born March 8, 1933 in Ancram, NY, he was the son of the late Clayton Traver and the late Mary Fagan Traver. He was also predeceased by his sisters Mary Eileen Traver and Jane Elizabeth Traver.
