Mount Marion –Kenneth F. deThomas died Thursday, November 5, 2020 at home. He was 86 years old.

Born April 11, 1934 in the Bronx, he was the son of the late Ralph deThomas and the late Carol Ann Rokohl. His wife Mary Jane LoCicero deThomas died in 1991.

A veteran of the Korean War, Ken served in the US Navy from 1951 until 1953. Formerly employed by General Stenciling in Brooklyn, he retired from Benedictine Hospital where he worked in the Engineering and Maintenance Department. An avid Yankee and Ranger fan, he enjoyed cooking, fishing and hunting.
