OBITUARY INFORMATION Saugerties – Margaret “Peg” Cummins died Thursday, December 18, 2008 at Kingston Hospital. She was 72 years old. She was born January 15, 1936 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the daughter of James & Lillian Gould. Her husband, Patrick Cummins whom she married June 21, 1958, died on April 29, 1998. Mrs. Cummins graduated from the University of Wisconsin with a B.S. in Education and taught 4th grade in Milwaukee. She and her husband moved to Saugerties in 1967. A parishioner of St. Mary of the Snow, she was also a member of the Prayer Group at St. Mary’s. She had served on the Parish Council, was a CCD teacher, an aid at St. Mary’s Daycare, a Eucharistic Minister, and worked in the Library of both St. Mary of the Snow School and Coleman High School. She volunteered as a Brownie Leader, was a member of the Ulster County Girl Scout Camp Committee, a former member of the Committee of Pack 33. She was a participant of and member of the Fresh Air Fund Committee. She also volunteered at The Well in Saugerties and for Ulster County Birthright. She is survived by two daughters, Cathy Stubblefield of Saugerties, and Eileen Cummins of Colonie, NY; and by two sons, Michael and Timothy Cummins, both of Saugerties; and by four grandchildren, Antoine Cummins and Tatiana Stubblefield of Saugerties and Madison and Noah Halter of Colonie. A Funeral procession will form 9:15 AM Tuesday, December 22, 2008 at Buono Funeral Service, Inc., Main Street Chapel, Saugerties, NY and then proceed to St. Mary of the Snow where an 10:00 AM a Mass of Christian Burial will be
