Along with her husband, she was the proprietor of Blue Ribbon Cleaners in Saugerties from 1948 until her retirement in 1978. Mrs. Francello was a parishioner of St. Mary of the Snow and a member of the Altar Rosary Society. She and her husband were benefactors of the building of St. Mary's Parochial School, and she received a Papal commendation for her volunteer work with St. Mary's CYO; she was also a member of the Saugerties Senior Citizen's Club. Mrs. Francello was a devoted mother and grandmother who enjoyed cooking and gardening. She is survived by a son, Robert Francello, and a daughter, Diana Voerg, both of Saugerties, NY. She has ten grandchildren, nine great grandchildren, as well as many nieces and nephews.
