September 23, 1916 - February 24, 2015

Malden-on-Hudson, NY – Olga Arnesen died Tuesday, February 24, 2015 at the Baptist Home in Rhinebeck. She was 98 years old.

Born September 23, 1916 in Averoy, Norway, she was the daughter of Ole and Thora Bjernevik

Tveekrem. On March 5, 1943 she married Egil Arnesen who pre-deceased her in 1973.
