Saugerties - Ralph Bogert died suddenly at his home in Saugerties on Monday, October 20, 2008. He was 75. He was born June 10, 1933, in Kingston, NY, the son of the late Abraham and Alice Bogert. On October 12, 1956 he married Ann Louise Palisi with whom he recently celebrated their 52 anniversary. In addition to Annie, his wife of 52 years, he is survived by their six sons, Steven and his wife Ann of Saugerties, Christopher of Littleton Colorado, Patrick and his wife Kathy of Lake Katrine, Daniel of Fairplay Colorado, Mathew and his wife Crista of Glenelg, and Roger and his fiancée Miki of Penns Grove, NJ; 14 grand children, Miranda, Aaron, Ariel, Stephanie, Mallory, Paisley, Patrick, Tim, Kayleigh, Brandon, Collin, Cole, Crew and Riley, and 3 great grandchildren, Dominic, Saydre and Gavin; and by his sister, Jeanne Armour of Easthampton, Massachusetts, and a nephew, Stewart Armour of Japan. Mr Bogert was a retired crane operator and 35 year member of the Operating Engineers local 825. He served in the Navy Sea Bees from 1952-1958. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign War Post #5034 in Saugerties and Palenville Post# 1604 American Legion. He was a lifetime member of the Ridge Runners Rod and Gun Club, a member of the NRA, a former Boy Scout Troop Leader, former president of the Kaaterskill Snowmobile Association, and race director of the United States Snowmobile Association. He served as caretaker of the Blue Mountain cemetery for ten years and was a longtime member of the Saxton Fire company. Most recently he became a member of the Hudson Valley old time power association and

was active in the Republican Party as a councilman serving on several committees including the local organization SOS and the election campaign of Holly Carnright. He enjoyed tending to his apple and peach trees, his raspberry patch and grape vines and the many varieties of evergreens he had planted on his property. He also loved salmon as well as deep sea fishing. He was most widely known as a frequent contributor to the Saugerties Post Star letters to the editor column. Funeral services will be held 11:00 am Saturday, October 25, 2008 at Buono Funeral Service, Inc., Main Street Chapel, Saugerties, NY. Cremation will follow and his ashes will be scattered by his sons over High Peak Mountain behind his home.
