



Richard Hlavsa

October 24, 1931 - September 16, 2007

Lomontville – Richard Hlavsa, a full-time area resident since 1993, died Sunday, September 16, 2007 at Westchester Medical Center in Valhalla, NY as a result of injuries sustained in an automobile accident. He was 75 years old. Mr. Hlavsa was born October 24, 1931 in New York City, the son of Anton and Hedwig Capita Hlavsa. He married his wife, Virginia, on December 22, 1951. He was the proprietor of Hlavsa Fuel Oil Company in Long Island City for over 40 years. Upon his retirement he became a broker for fuel oil companies. An Ombudsman to Golden Hill Health Related Facility, he was very active with Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Ulster County as well as CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates). Mr. Hlavsa was also active in the Marbletown Land Owners Association and involved in Property Tax Reform. In addition to his wife, Vivi at home; he is survived by a son David Hlavsa, his daughter-in-law Lisa Holtby, and a grandson, Benjamin Hlavsa all of Seattle Washington; and a sister, Doris Hlavsa of North Providence, RI.
