March 1, 1946 - January 7, 2024

### OBITUARY INFORMATION

Glasco – Robert L. Ciarlante died, Sunday January 7, 2024 surrounded by his family at home. He was 77 years old.

Born March 1, 1946 in Kingston, he was the son of the late Thomas G. Ciarlante and the late Ida M. Resso Ciarlante. The proprietor of Ciarlante Paving for most of his life, he also served as the Highway Superintendent of the Village of Saugerties from 2000 until 2015 and worked for the Ulster County Highway Department in 1999. From a young age Bob worked in the family business ICE and Coal until he was drafted in the US Army during Vietnam. He served from 1966 until 1968.

A parishioner of St. Joseph's Church in Glasco, he was a member of the Holy Name Society and had served as president. He was also a member of Glasco Fire Company. Line Dancing was a favorite activity and he also enjoyed antique cars and preserving the history of his family business, the ice and coal company.

Survivors include his daughters, Nadena Penovich and her husband Rich, Alison Ciarlante, Barbie Quick, Allyson Decicco and Stephanie Pranis; his grandchildren Brian "Butchy" Ciarlante, Tyler Penovich, and Trevor "Jimmy" Penovich; his great-grandson Jamison Cahill; his sister Rose Buonfiglio; his

dear friend Mary Demelfi, her children Angie and Dave Welling and their children Katy and Alex; and his cousin Stephen Sasso, whom he thought of as a brother. His canine companion Mac, several cousins and many friends also survive. He was pre-deceased by his siblings, Thomas Ciarlante, Anthony Ciarlante, and Marie Arena; and by his son-in-law Steven Quick.

A Funeral procession will form 10:15 AM, Friday, January 12, 2024 at Buono Funeral Service, Inc., Saugerties, NY and then proceed to St. Joseph's RC Church in Glasco where at 11:00 AM a Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated. 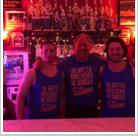
