Saugerties ? Robert T. ?Bob? Curry, longtime business man and best friend to many, died Friday, March 23, 2007 at Kingston Hospital in Kingston. He was 63 years old. He was born June 29, 1943 in Manhattan, the son of Edward and Jeanette Bogdanowitz Curry. He married the former Barbara Mayer on March 31, 1984. Along with his brother he was the proprietor of Curry Brothers Service Station in Barclay Heights, Saugerties. He was a parishioner of St. John the Evangelist Parish in Centerville, where he served as a CCD instructor. He was a Life member of Saxton Fire Co. and currently serves as the Chairmen of the Board of Fire Commissioners. He attended Cardinal Hayes High School in the Bronx and graduated from Saugerties High School in 1961. He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1962 until 1965 and was reactivated from the reserves during the Pueblo Incident of 1968. He was formerly a member of the Saugerties JayCees. He was an AYSO Soccer Coach as well as a Little League Baseball Coach. He was also s member of the Saugerties Knights of Columbus #4536 In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter Leslie Michelle Curry of Putwana, SD; two sons, John Sinclair Curry of Highland, NY and Robert Thomas Curry, Jr. of Saugerties; Two brothers, Edward Curry of Lansdale, PA, and George Curry and his wife, Mary Ellen, of Palenville, NY; three sisters, Helen Avagliano and her husband, Frank of Saugerties, Janet Curry of Saugerties, and Debbie Littlefield and her husband, Gary of Saugerties; and by Donna Curry, mother of John & Leslie Curry. He is also survived by many in-laws, nieces and nephews. He was pre-

deceased by his sister, Loraine Blake on July 25, 1992.
