July 10, 1933 - August 27, 2018

Saugerties ---Ronald Bernard Deak, Sr. died peacefully at home while surrounded by his family on Monday, August 27, 2018. He was 85 years old. Born July 10, 1933 in Brooklyn, he was the son of Bernard and Gisella (Rochnyak) Deak and grew up in Queens. On October 17, 1953 he married Elizabeth Seissler, with whom he raised a family, and together they became proprietors of Wallpaper World in Lake Katrine. As a young man, he joined the National Guard, and enjoyed teaching middle school before becoming a business owner for over 30 years. Liz followed her husband just six days later and passed on September 2, 2018.

Ron was a devout Roman Catholic, an avid reader, a musician, and a tennis enthusiast. He enjoyed seeing live musical theater, and had performed in several local theater performances during his retirement in Florida. He also volunteered for the organization Big Brothers/Big Sisters, and mentored a child for many years.

He is survived by five children, Suzanne and her husband Ludwig Wittig, Ronald and his wife Leeann Deak, Dianne and her husband Thomas Hunt, Betsy and her husband Raymond Lastner, and James and his wife, Kristen Deak. He is also survived by six grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.

A combined funeral for Liz and Ron Deak is planned.
