



## Ross P. Melville

July 11, 1932 - November 12, 2007

Saugerties – Ross P. Melville died Monday, November 12, 2007 at Tenbroeck Commons Nursing Home in Lake Katrine. He was 75 years old. He was born July 11, 1932 in the Bronx, the son of Ross S. and Margaret Phillips Melville. He married the former Jean Quinn. He was a retired welder from Hudson Cement in East Kingston, NY. He served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict and was awarded the Combat Infantry Badge, UN Service Medal, and the Korean Service Medal with two Bronze Camp Stars. He was a member of the Saugerties Sports Hall of Fame. He was also a charter member of Saugerties Knights of Columbus Council # 4536. He was a former member of the VFW and American Legion. In addition to his wife Jean, he is survived by four children, Michael and his wife Diane of Saugerties, Patricia Olson and her husband Kevin of Saugerties, Peggy Melville of Saugerties, and Laurie Dederick and her husband Ralph of Saugerties; a brother, Ian Melville of Quarryville; three grandchildren, Scott & Michelle Melville and Dakota Olson; and several nieces and nephews.
