Saugerties – Thomas Ciarlante died Wednesday, March 11, 2009 at Golden Hill Health Related Facility in Kingston. He was 83 years old. He was born September 17, 1925 in Glasco, NY the son of Thomas and Ida Resso Ciarlante. He retired as a kiln operator from Ferroxcube in Saugerties.
