Glasco – Vincent Anthony Buono, Sr. died Wednesday, June 11, 2008 at Ferncliff Nursing Home. He was 86 years old. He was born March 8, 1922 in Glasco, the son of Frank and Mary Mauro Buono. He grew up in Glasco and attended Glasco Union Free School. He graduated Saugerties High School in 1939. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corp as a radio dispatcher in the China-Burma-India Campaign and Asian Theatre. He was the proprietor of Vincent's Barber Shop and from 1960 to 1972 the proprietor of The Corner Restaurant in Saugerties. He enjoyed playing his saxophone and working in his garden.
